





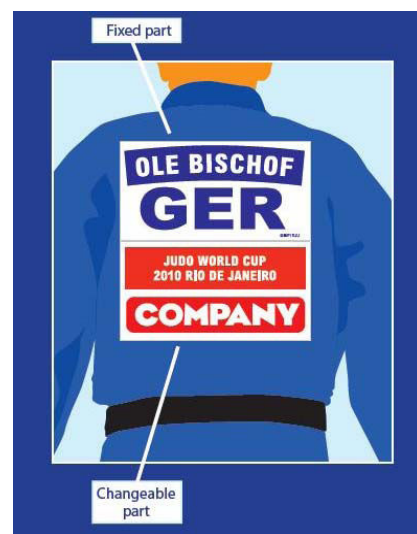

<b>Participants</b>	Boys and girls born in <b>1994-1995</b> In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the Jumas deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.

<p><b>Competition system</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Competition will be carried out according to the IJF/EJU official rules (Double Repechage system). Golden Score from semifinals.</li> <li>• Time of fights: 4 minutes; Golden score: 2 minutes</li> <li>• Preliminaries – 4 mats (8m x 8m)</li> <li>• Semifinals – 2 mats (8m x 8m)</li> <li>• Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m)</li> </ul> <p>Competition systems with low number of participants:  2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide  3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin).  6 and more entries: double repechage competition system</p>
<p><b>Special Referring Rules for Cadets</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If torus applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition.</li> <li>• Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Judogi and backnumbers</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The white and blue judogi are obligatory.</li> <li>• Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule.</li> <li>• All competitors are obliged to have back number on their judogi:</li> </ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.</li> <li>2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from <a href="http://www.mybacknumber.com">www.mybacknumber.com</a>. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.</li> <li>3. The CHANGEABLE part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.</li> </ol> <p>The athletes must arrive at the competition hall with their back numbers already sewn on the Judogi. The organizing committee will provide a sewing machine and stock of back numbers close to the Warm Up Area, and offer the service to sew on Back Numbers for free in case of damaged back numbers during the competition. Athletes who either arrived without back number sewn or whose back number is damaged, can avail themselves of this service by paying € 50 per fee per back number. No athletes will be allowed to enter the Tatami without the Sponsor Back number.</p> <p>As advised during the EJU Ordinary Congress 2010, the EJU decided to allocate the space on the shoulder stripes only to EJU official suppliers,</p>



	<p>for all official EJU Tournaments (starting from the 15th of February). The other advertising spaces, as allocated by the IJF, remain as before. Therefore, Judogi with advertising of non-suppliers on shoulder stripes cannot be used. Judoka who like to compete must ensure that the Judogi conforms to these rules and therefore remove the non-EJU Official Supplier advertising or change the jacket. It is not allowed to tape or cover any non-authorized suppliers as this would affect the judogi design and the grip of the opponent.</p>	
<b>Referees</b>	<p>All participating National Federations are kindly requested to bring International referee to secure neutral refereeing.</p>

All payments should be done in cash during accreditation. Accommodation should be only booked through Russian Judo Federation. The deadline for bookings - <b><u>12 March 2010.</u></b></p>	
<b>Transport</b>	<p>National Federations are responsible for their own expenses to/from Moscow. Organizers will provide domestic transportation from/to Moscow airport/railway station to/from Tver and between official hotels and sporthall.</p>	
<b>Liability</b>	<p>Neither the organizers of the event or Russian Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury, nor for any loss or damage of property in connection with the trip and participation on this tournament and training camp.</p>	
<b>Entries</b>	<p><b>a) First entry</b> National federations are requested to inform the Russian Judo Federation as to whether they will participate in the tournament or not by prescribed entry form not later than <b><u>10 February 2010.</u></b></p> <p><b>b) Final entry</b> National federations are requested to send the final forms not later than <b><u>29 March 2010.</u></b></p>	

<b>VISA</b>	<p>In case you require visa to enter Russia, we kindly ask you to complete visa application form and send it to the Russian Judo Federation by fax <b>+7 (495) 637 02 57</b> or by email <a href="mailto:rjf@judo.ru">rjf@judo.ru</a> and <a href="mailto:rusjudo@gmail.com">rusjudo@gmail.com</a> not later than <b><u>20 February 2010.</u></b></p> <p><b>Please be informed that it usually takes 5-7 working days to get approval from our Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Only after the receiving of this approval we can send you the invitation with confirmation. To obtain this approval <u>first page of the passport with photo and personal data is obligatory.</u></b></p>
